SIRA web site (wordpress) is up but still very static, with room for improvement. *Volunteers* are welcome.

SIRA is now a member of Informatics Europe. Martin Glinz attended IE's annual ECSS Conference in October 2020 (planned for Sofia, Bulgaria, actually held virtually). There was also a half-day National Informatics Associations Workshop on *Interdisciplinarity and Informatics* where Martin Glinz chaired a session.

No progress on student statistics. *Volunteers are welcome*, some funding would be available for them.

Martin Glinz has been re-elected as SI board member and will represent SIRA on the SI board.

The SIRA offer to support mediation of conflict within the SI board was not made use of, but there is reason for hope that the SI board will find back to a constructive and collaborative working style.
