#### Negative Interest:

Should SIRA move part of its Postfinance account to a Postfinance funds? One opinion: rather no, too complicated, and little benefits.

**Vote** on moving Half of assets to funds: **yes 8**, no 2, abstention 3. → Approved.

## 3e. Varia

GDMS points out the Swiss government position to consider cloud services operated by foreign nations (US, China). Should a position statement be written?

Vote 8 yes, 3 abstentions

CT points out that the SNSF explicitly condemns "Switzerland first" positions but so far has avoided denouncing "EU first". Both the SNSF and the SERI/SBFI/SEFRI did not want to attend the SIRA conference for presenting and discussing the rift with the EU regarding participation in the Horizon Europe program.

"Für eine allgemeine Übersicht zum Thema Horizon Europe ist das SBF oder allenfalls Euresearch der geeignetere Ansprechpartner."

"Wir schlagen vor [da keine Informationen zu Digital Europe vorliegen], dass Sie sich für die Jahresversammlung nächstes Jahr wieder bei uns melden, um zu diesem Zeitpunkt eine mögliche SBFI-Teilnahme zu organisieren".

Should the board write a statement to SNFS/SBF?

Several contributions supporting also this and point out the more general discussion of politization of science where research should bow to political agenda which change depending on geopolitical interests (e.g. boycott of Iran).
